WILDLIFE TOURISM IS SUCH A NICHE MARKET AND IS WORLDWIDE ONE OF THE FASTEST-GROWING ONES (MINTEL INTERNATIONAL GROUP LTD, 2008A). WESTERN EUROPEANS IN SPECIFIC HAVE “DEVELOPED AN UNPRECEDENTED AFFINITY FOR DAYTRIPS OR HOLIDAYS IN NATURAL AREAS” (VAN EGMOND, 2008, P. 85) AND WILDLIFE WATCHING IS ONE OF THE KEY REASONS WHY PEOPLE VISIT NATURAL AREAS (MINTEL INTERNATIONAL GROUP LTD, 2008A). SEVERAL EUROPEAN COUNTRIES HAVE ALREADY ESTABLISHED AN IMPRESSIVE RANGE OF WILDLIFE-BASED TOURS. WOLF HOWLING TOURS IN ITALY AND BEAR TRACKING TOURS IN THE CARPATHIAN MOUNTAINS ARE STEADILY GAINING POPULARITY AMONG TOURISTS (HOFRICHTER & BERGER, 2004) AND THE CANARY ISLANDS RECORD OVER ONE MILLION WHALE WATCHING PARTICIPANTS PER YEAR (HOYT, 2000).
